

Equal Groups

Concept — ANSWER KEY

Equal groups → adding → multiplying.

Think: Count how many groups, and how many are in each group. Adding equal groups IS multiplying.

1. Count the equal groups. Write it as adding, and as multiplying.

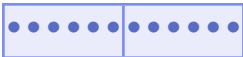
1) How many cars in all?



There are **5** groups of **5**.

$$5 + 5 + 5 + 5 + 5 = \mathbf{25} \quad \text{or} \quad \mathbf{5 \times 5 = 25}$$

3) How many crayons in all?



There are **2** groups of **6**.

$$6 + 6 = \mathbf{12} \quad \text{or} \quad \mathbf{2 \times 6 = 12}$$

5) How many apples in all?



There are **2** groups of **3**.

$$3 + 3 = \mathbf{6} \quad \text{or} \quad \mathbf{2 \times 3 = 6}$$

7) How many stamps in all?



There are **4** groups of **3**.

$$3 + 3 + 3 + 3 = \mathbf{12} \quad \text{or} \quad \mathbf{4 \times 3 = 12}$$

2) How many leaves in all?



There are **3** groups of **4**.

$$4 + 4 + 4 = \mathbf{12} \quad \text{or} \quad \mathbf{3 \times 4 = 12}$$

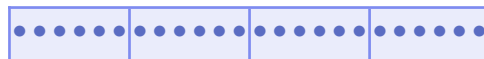
4) How many wheels in all?



There are **3** groups of **4**.

$$4 + 4 + 4 = \mathbf{12} \quad \text{or} \quad \mathbf{3 \times 4 = 12}$$

6) How many eggs in all?



There are **4** groups of **6**.

$$6 + 6 + 6 + 6 = \mathbf{24} \quad \text{or} \quad \mathbf{4 \times 6 = 24}$$

8) How many shells in all?



There are **4** groups of **2**.

$$2 + 2 + 2 + 2 = \mathbf{8} \quad \text{or} \quad \mathbf{4 \times 2 = 8}$$
