

Equal Groups

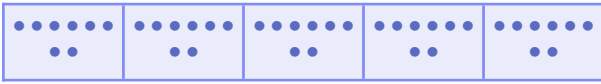
Practice — ANSWER KEY

Bigger groups, same idea.

Think: Adding the same number again and again is the same as multiplying by how many times.

1. Count the equal groups. Write it as adding, and as multiplying.

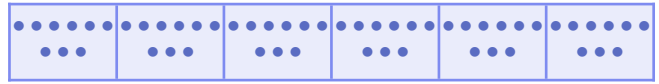
1) How many stars in all?



There are **5** groups of **8**.

$$8 + 8 + 8 + 8 + 8 = 40 \quad \text{or} \quad 5 \times 8 = 40$$

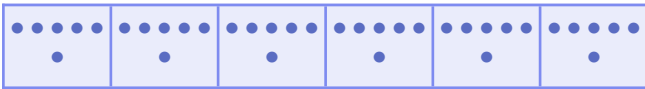
2) How many leaves in all?



There are **6** groups of **9**.

$$9 + 9 + 9 + 9 + 9 + 9 = 54 \quad \text{or} \quad 6 \times 9 = 54$$

3) How many eggs in all?



There are **6** groups of **6**.

$$6 + 6 + 6 + 6 + 6 + 6 = 36 \quad \text{or} \quad 6 \times 6 = 36$$

4) How many leaves in all?



There are **5** groups of **3**.

$$3 + 3 + 3 + 3 + 3 = 15 \quad \text{or} \quad 5 \times 3 = 15$$

5) How many books in all?



There are **5** groups of **9**.

$$9 + 9 + 9 + 9 + 9 = 45 \quad \text{or} \quad 5 \times 9 = 45$$

6) How many books in all?



There are **4** groups of **3**.

$$3 + 3 + 3 + 3 = 12 \quad \text{or} \quad 4 \times 3 = 12$$

7) How many stamps in all?



There are **3** groups of **7**.

$$7 + 7 + 7 = 21 \quad \text{or} \quad 3 \times 7 = 21$$

8) How many buttons in all?



There are **3** groups of **7**.

$$7 + 7 + 7 = 21 \quad \text{or} \quad 3 \times 7 = 21$$
