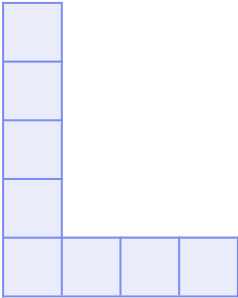

Think: Cutting a corner rectangle out SHRINKS the area but keeps the perimeter the SAME.

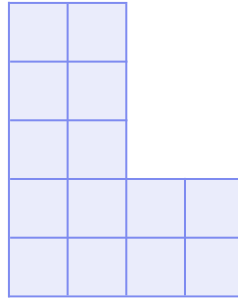
1. Solve each one. Reason it out!

- 1) A 4×3 corner was cut from this 5×4 rectangle. What is the AREA of the remaining shape, in square cm?



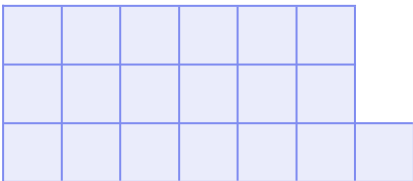

- 2) A 3×2 corner was cut from this 5×4 rectangle. What is the AREA of the remaining shape, in square cm?



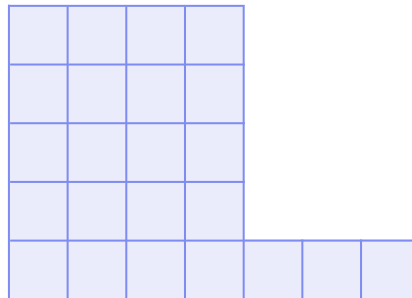

- 3) A 2×1 corner was cut from this 3×7 rectangle. What is the AREA of the remaining shape, in square cm?



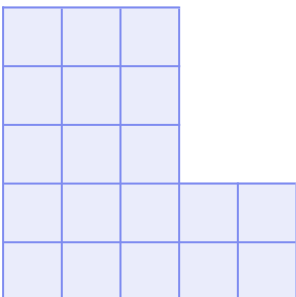

- 4) A 4×3 corner was cut from this 5×7 rectangle. What is the AREA of the remaining shape, in square cm?



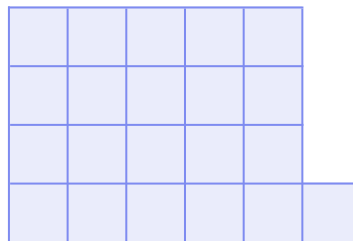
