1. Each letter stands for a whole number. Solve one letter, then use it in the next line.

1) Find each letter.

$$C + C = 2$$

$$C + Y = 15$$

$$C + K = 15$$

$$N - C = 7$$

$$C = \underline{\quad} \quad Y = \underline{\quad} \quad K = \underline{\quad} \quad N = \underline{\quad}$$

3) Find each letter.

$$R + R = 2$$

$$R + J = 5$$

$$J + M = 15$$

$$M + P = 12$$

2) Find each letter.

$$D + D = 6$$

$$D + E = 10$$

$$D + D = 10$$
